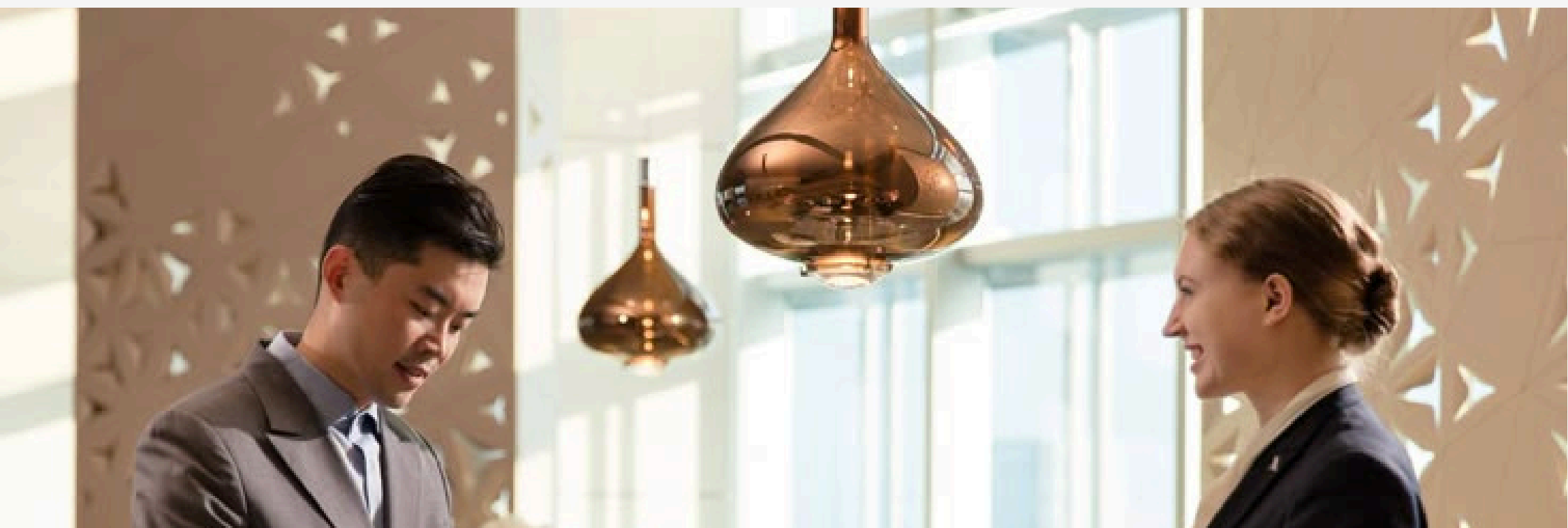

Starting Package

¥2.8 million – ¥4.0 million per year for new graduates

- While starting salaries are moderate, with experience (3–5 years) and higher Japanese language skills (plus English), you can advance into supervisory/management roles.
- Given the labour-shortage context, international students with strong Japanese + tourism credentials may gain valuable advantage.

Additional Information

- Students can expect their total annual cost for tuition and accommodation (from the 2nd year onward) to stay within **13,00,000 JPY per year**.
- Since the Bachelor's Degree is offered entirely in Japanese, students are required to meet **JLPT N3 proficiency** by the time academic classes begin.
- **Language Training (N5 → N4 → N3) will be provided in India** as the first phase of the pathway, preparing students to meet the Japanese-medium requirements.
- Before enrollment, **students must clear an entrance test** conducted by the University, in India.

Employment Outcomes

The Department of International Tourism at Nagasaki International University has consistently demonstrated strong career support for its graduates. Among Reiwa 6 (2024) graduates, **Japanese students achieved an employment rate of 98.1%, while international students achieved 94.4%, resulting in an overall employment rate of 97.7%.** A majority of graduates successfully secured positions in tourism-related and hospitality-related fields, with a small number pursuing higher education.

Indian students, in particular, enjoy a strong advantage through specialised Japanese-language programs, practical training, and robust industry connections. These resources equip them to confidently secure employment in Japan and internationally, ensuring a smooth transition into successful careers in tourism, hospitality, and related sectors.
