The programme is designed to equip students with:

- Core business and management knowledge
- Global economic and trade understanding
- Cross-cultural communication skills
- Practical exposure through internships and work experience



Programme Highlights

- **English-Taught Degree:** The programme is fully taught in English, with no Japanese language proficiency required at entry.
- **Japanese Language Classes:** Japanese language classes are mandatory in the first and second years and are conducted twice a week as part of the curriculum.
- **Global Classroom:** Students learn in a multicultural classroom alongside Japanese peers fluent in English, ensuring smooth communication and cultural exchange.
- **Practical Business Education:** The curriculum focuses on case studies and real-world business applications to develop industry-relevant skills.
- **Mandatory Internship:** A mandatory internship in Japan provides students with hands-on professional experience during the programme.



Accommodation & Student Support

The university offers **limited university-linked accommodation** for international students, subject to availability. In cases where on-campus or affiliated housing is full, **students are actively assisted** in securing suitable off-campus accommodation near the campus.

The average monthly food and accommodation cost is **¥60,000 to ¥75,000**, depending on room type and location. Guidance is provided throughout the housing process to ensure a safe, convenient, and student-friendly living arrangement.

Student Support System

A **structured student support system** is in place to help international students settle smoothly into life in Japan. The support includes:

- Assistance with housing and local arrangements
- Guidance for daily life in Japan, including transport and essentials
- Local orientation and cultural familiarisation
- Access to dedicated international student support for ongoing academic and personal assistance



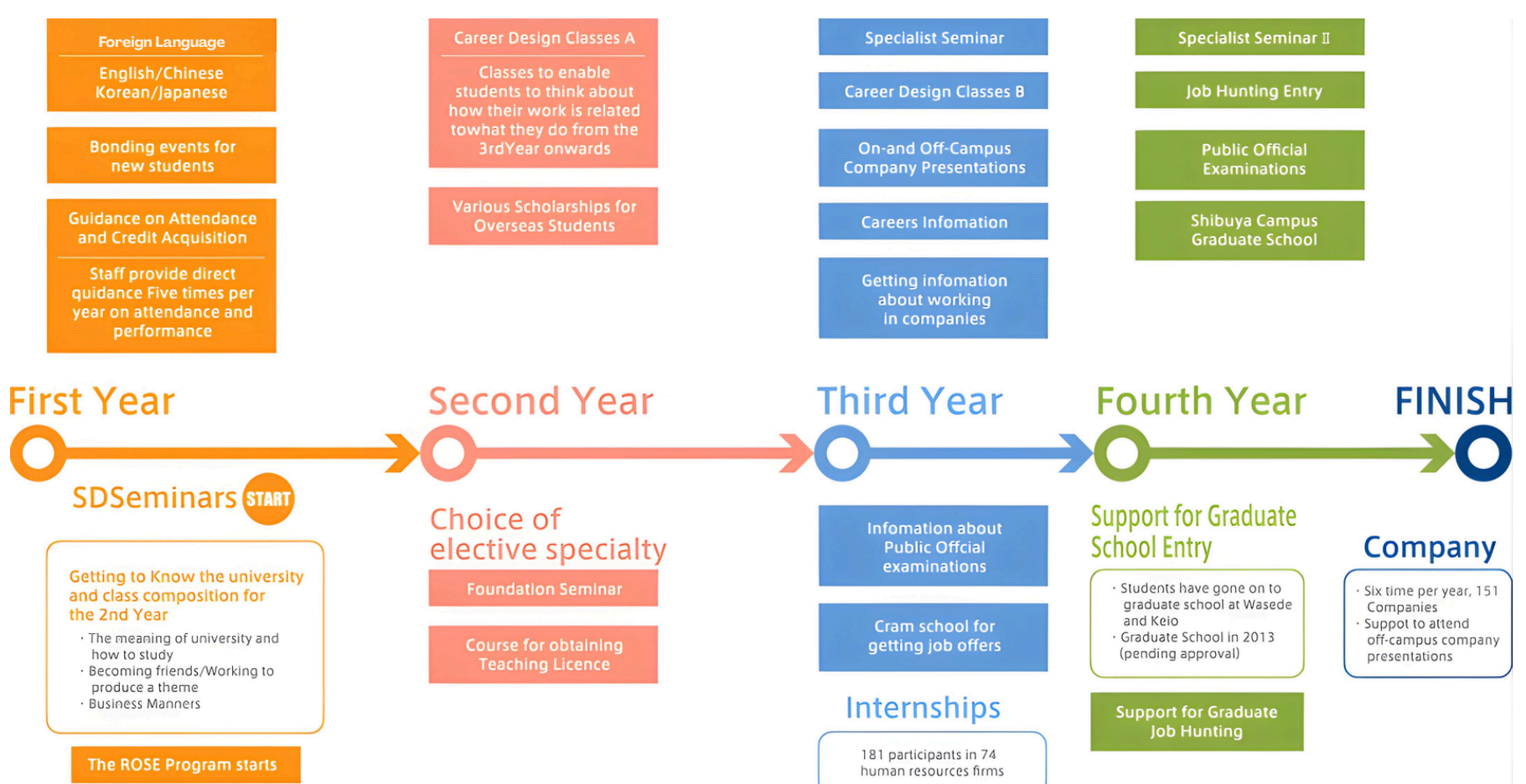
Internships & Career Pathways

Hands-on professional experience is a core component of the academic journey at Japan University of Economics, where the internship system seamlessly connects classroom learning with real-world business practice.

Structured internships allow students **to apply their major studies in industry settings** aligned with their academic interests, helping them develop professional skills, understand corporate culture, and gain firsthand exposure to business environments.

Integrated into the university's ongoing career learning progression, internships are undertaken at different stages of study with guidance from faculty and career advisers, enabling students to build confidence, strengthen communication skills, and align practical experience with long-term career goals in Japan or the global business arena.

One-time Admission Fee of 1,50,000 JPY is payable separately at the time of enrollment.

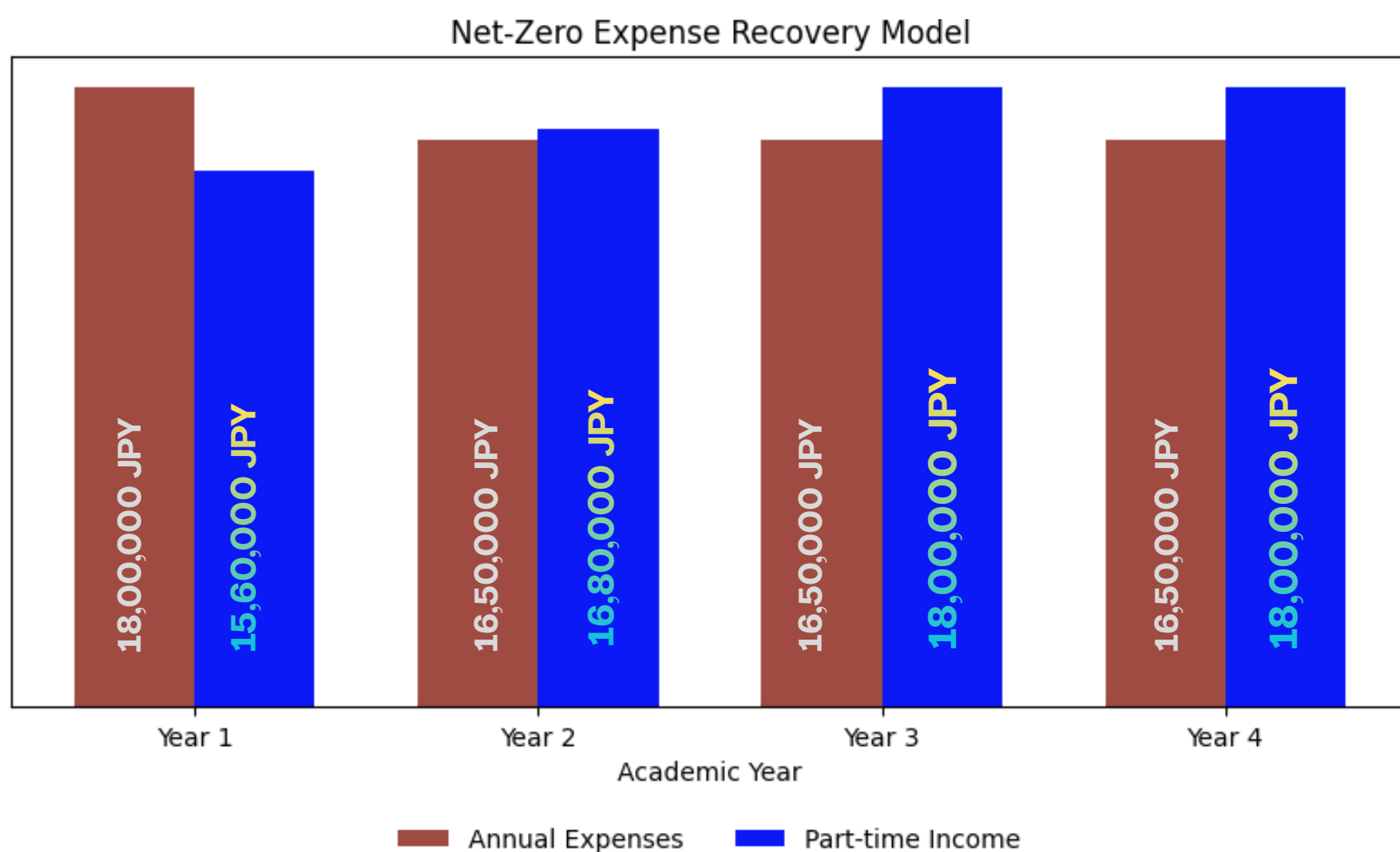
Additional Information

- The Bachelor's Degree is **offered entirely in English.**
- Students are strongly **encouraged to learn Japanese** up to JLPT N4 level to:
 - Adapt comfortably to daily life in Japan
 - Communicate effectively
 - Access part-time job opportunities
- Japanese language training **will be provided** as part of the student support pathway.
- The university may conduct an online assessment as part of the admission process.
- **Shared living expenses** charges range from **60,000-75,000 JPY/month** and are not included in the annual fee.
- The annual fee of ₹4.5 Lakhs (7,50,000 JPY) applies per academic year, subject to university regulations.

Recovery Model

Part-time work **is a mandatory and built-in part** of student life in Japan, providing students with a steady monthly income that directly supports their living expenses. As students progress, their earning capacity increases, ensuring consistent financial support alongside academics.

When total expenses are compared with part-time earnings over the duration of the program, the costs are largely recovered. By the later years, income matches or exceeds annual expenses, making the program an almost net-zero expense, where students are able to fund their education and living costs independently.
